Sweden is represented in the JPIAMR by the The Swedish Research Council (Vetenskapsrådet, VR). The Swedish government recognises the threat of antimicrobial resistance and is committed to combat AMR both nationally and internationally, and has been a strong advocate for international cooperation for AMR research. Sweden also participates in several international programs and initiatives relevant for AMR, such as “ReACT – Action on Antibiotic Resistance” where the main funder is the Swedish International Development Cooperation Agency (Sida).
